- Frozen custard, by definition, is a premium ice cream. It's made with a little bit of egg yolk solids added to the mix to give it a richer flavor and velvety, smooth texture.
- Each Culver's restaurant makes our signature frozen custard fresh, many times each day, in customized machines right on the premises in the guest's view.
- To be called frozen custard, a product must contain a minimum of 10 percent butterfat content. Culver's vanilla formula contains 13 percent butterfat, and the chocolate contains 10 percent butterfat.
- Ice cream is frozen to -10°F when it is packaged and may sit in a freezer for months. Culver's frozen custard is served fresh throughout the day at 18 - 21°F, so it doesn't form ice crystals.
- Frozen custard has less air than ice cream (20-30% compared to 100-120%) so less air equals a delicious density.
- Chocolate, vanilla and a Flavor of the Day are available everyday.

- Each Flavor of the Day recipe is made with fresh fruits, nuts, candy, background flavors and/or extracts – over 100 recipes are proven taste bud pleasers.
- If your taste buds crave a different flavor, just ask. We can personalize your flavor of the day by mixing in any of our more than 30 types of nuts, fruit and candy toppings.
- Sundaes and cones can be created in a variety of sizes (1-3 scoops) to fit any appetite.
