## Hershey®'s Kisses® Brand Chocolates – 100 Years of Milestones

Milton S. Hershey introduced the world to *Hershey*® 's *Kisses*® Brand Chocolates in 1907. Today, the silver-wrapped *Hershey* 's *Kisses* Chocolates are a brand icon and symbol of affection the world over. Here is a look back at 100 years of magical moments:

1907	Milton S. Hershey introduces <i>Hershey's Kisses</i> Chocolates. The conical-shaped chocolates are wrapped by hand in silver foil with a tissue-paper insert.
1921	Hershey's Kisses Chocolates are no longer hand-wrapped due to the introduction of the first foil-wrapping machine, and the tissue-paper insert is replaced with the iconic plume.
1924	Milton S. Hershey secures a trademark for the <i>Hershey's Kisses</i> name and plume.
1942	For the first and only time in history, production of <i>Hershey's Kisses</i> Chocolates ceases due to the rationing of silver foil during and after World War II.
1949	Hershey's Kisses Chocolates resume production following World War II.
1962	Hershey's Kisses Chocolates are wrapped in colored foil for the first time – red and green foil-wrapped Hershey's Kisses Chocolates are introduced for the Christmas season.
1968	Pastel blue, pink and green foil wrappers are introduced for the Easter holiday.
1976	Hershey secures a trademark for the familiar <i>Hershey's Kisses</i> Chocolates conical shape wrapped in foil.
1986	Hershey's Kisses Chocolates debut Valentine's Day-themed foils.
1990	Hershey introduces Hershey's Kisses Chocolates with almonds.
1993	Hershey introduces <i>Hershey's Hugs</i> Chocolates – miniature <i>Hershey's Kisses</i> "hugged" by white chocolate.

2002 Hershey introduces the first-ever Limited-Edition Hershey's Kisses Chocolates, the Hershev's rich dark chocolates. Since then, Limited-Edition Hershev's Kisses Chocolates have included flavors such as toffee with almonds, extra creamy, double fudge and strawberry crème. 2003 Hershey's Kisses rich dark chocolate is launched as a permanent addition to the Hershey's Kisses Chocolates portfolio. Hershey combines the two most popular confectionery ingredients to introduce *Hershey's* 2004 Kisses Chocolates with caramel. 2006 Hershey introduces Hershey's Kisses Chocolate Truffles and Hershey's Kisses Chocolates with candy cane bits. 2007 The Hershey Company celebrates 100 years of special moments and personal connections with Hershey's Kisses Chocolates and lets consumers customize plumes for special occasions through www.hersheygifts.com. Custom plume options include "It's a Girl," "It's a Boy," "Good Luck," "Over the Hill," "Best Wishes," "Congratulations," "I Love You," "Let's Celebrate," "Thank You" and "Happy Birthday."
