

ProStart[®] Program Fact Sheet

Overview

The ProStart program, developed by the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation (NRAEF) and managed nationally by National Restaurant Association Solutions, is a nationwide system of high school restaurant and foodservice courses linked with mentored worksite experiences. The ProStart program is comprised of state-driven industry and educational partnerships throughout the country, and it exists as the national umbrella organization for restaurant and foodservice career education. Currently, 60,000 high school students at 1,600 schools in 47 states, territories and districts are enrolled in the program. www.WeAreProStart.org

Industry Employment Challenge

- The \$511 billion restaurant and foodservice industry employs more people than any other private sector industry in the U.S., and this trend is expected to continue well into the future.
- The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects that the number of restaurant and foodservice industry jobs during the period of 2008 to 2018 will increase by approximately 2 million, of which approximately 47,000 will be management positions.
- Restaurant and foodservice managers rank industry employee availability and industry skill level second only to competition.
- Young people are unaware of the potential careers in the restaurant and foodservice industry.

ProStart Initiative Role

- Promote adoption of restaurant and foodservice curricula in high schools.
- Increase industry involvement in educational partnerships.
- Set standards for career education.
- Improve the restaurant and foodservice industry's image.
- Strengthen educator-industry partnerships.
- Assist in developing financial resources.
- Document the impact of the ProStart program.

ProStart Initiative Long-Term Goals

- Establish the restaurant and foodservice industry as the industry of choice for career seekers.
- Maintain the highest career education standards.
- Raise awareness about the ProStart program with high school students.
- Significantly increase the restaurant and foodservice industry's recruitment efforts.
- Create more national articulation agreements with colleges that offer restaurant and foodservice education curricula.
- Recognize industry leaders for their contribution to the ProStart program.
