## **Former Butler and Confidante of Princess Diana will Celebrate Her Life at Home and Garden Show**

For 21 years, Paul Burrell served the British Royal Family, living and working in some of the world's most elegant and beautifully furnished homes. "Princess Diana was very much in people's thoughts on that day."

Burrell will meet and greet with visitors at the **Suburban Home & Garden Show, February 23 - 26, at the Greater Philadelphia EXPO Center at Oaks**. A private, little-seen collection of gowns once worn by Princess Diana will be on display at the show, along with a short documentary commemorating the life of the beloved Royal.
