Dresses for Humanity II is a collection of clothing Diana auctioned for charity, as well as those designed by the late Princess' dear friend, Catherine Walker. As Diana flourished into a confident and independent royal, Walker's designs for her became more chic, tailored and elegant. Gowns to be featured include a formal long-sleeved burgundy dinner gown Diana wore to the 1985 *Back to the Future* movie premiere, a dark green velvet column gown Diana favored for private dinner parties at Kensington Palace, a pink silk Indian gown embroidered with green and star-shaped sequins, gold glass beads and gold braid, a dreamy Zandra Rhodes-designed cream chiffon gown she sported during her early years as a royal, and a black velvet gown she wore for an official Royal Portrait. Accompanying the display will be a short documentary detailing Diana's life journey to the status of global icon, which she still enjoys today, nearly 15 years after her death.

The Suburban Home & Garden Show also presents Diana's former butler **Paul Burrell**, who will meet and greet Show goers recalling stories of the favored Royal who called him her friend from 1987 until her death in 1997. Burrell will also show some furniture from his collaboration with Highland House, called Royal Manner II: Casual English Style.

The Show affords the opportunity to spruce up your "palace" at reasonable prices. With over 500 exhibitors, find everything needed for home design and build projects. The EXPO Center is located at 100 Station Avenue in Oaks, PA, just five minutes from Valley Forge and the King of Prussia Mall off the Oaks exit of Route 422.
