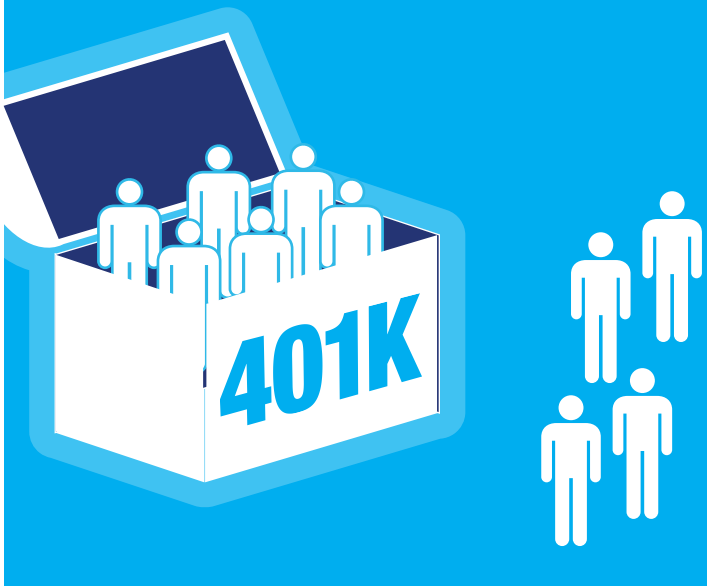
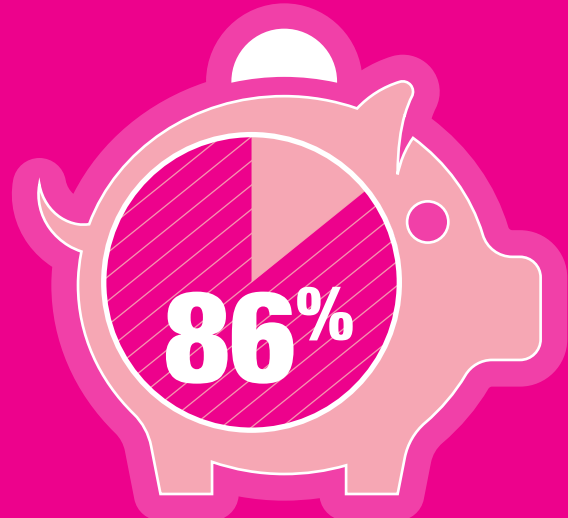


# Building a More Secure Financial Future for Virginians

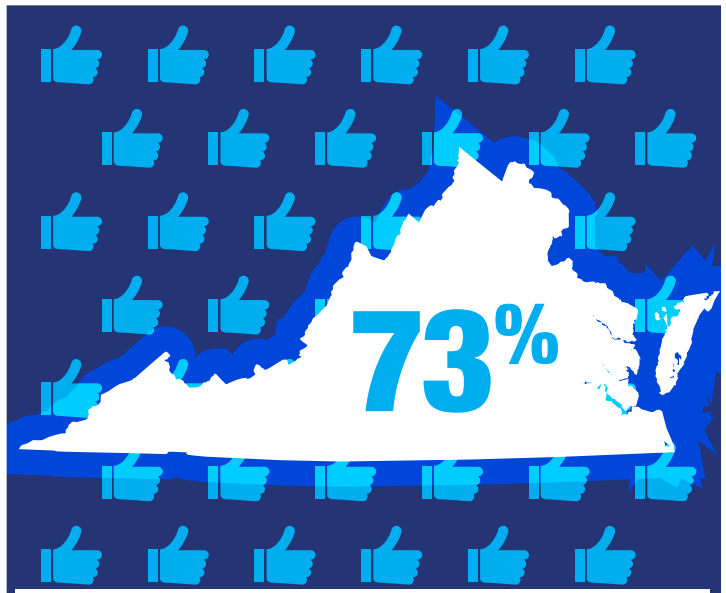
**4 in 10** Virginians don't have access to a retirement savings plan at work.<sup>1</sup>
